IMPORTANT NOTES FOR 2017/18

Dress Code

Bowls events will be played in attire as outlined:

PENNANT UNIFORM – Final Round of club championships. (Markers may be in free dress except for finals), Anzac Day, Gala Day, Opening Day, Presidents Day.

BOWLS ATTIRE – Monday Triples, Thursday 2.4.2, All rounds of club championships except the final round.

FREE DRESS – All other events will be played in free dress unless otherwise specified on the event entry sheet.

The definition of “free dress” is either smart casual which meets the Country Club dress code, pennant uniform or bowls attire.

Heat Policy

Purpose:

This policy sets out guidelines for Chirnside Park Country Club members, guests & visitors who wish to participate in bowls on days of high temperature.

The Clubs Board of Management has the responsibility for the implementation of this policy.

Guidelines:

- Social Events will commence as per the Fixture Book times.
- If the temperature reaches 32 Celsius the Committee will consider shortening, postponing or cancelling Social Events.
- When the temperature reaches 36 Celsius the greens will be closed, and Social Events cancelled.
- For all events the temperatures will be read from the Bureau of Meteorology website at Coldstream (Phone – 1196) Pennant Matches will be played under the Bowls Victoria “Inclement Weather” Rule. Rule No. 10 E.
- On days forecast to be over 35 Celsius it is the member's responsibility to contact the Club's Event Organiser regarding changes to the Event.
- Bowlers are encouraged to be attired with suitable clothing, sunscreen, hats, sun glasses & umbrellas and have plenty of non-alcoholic fluids with them to prevent dehydration.
- The Club (via the General Manager in consultation with the Bowls President or his representative) has the right to suspend or cancel casual and competition play in the event of extreme conditions and circumstances.

Club Championship Events

The Men's /Ladies sub-committee will coordinate these games. The rules and cost for these events will be displayed on the foyer notice board and these should be read and clearly understood prior to entry. Team's events to be paid as one entry and all members of the team are to provide their full name.

The Occupation Health & Safety Regulations regarding hot weather also applies to championship events.

GENERAL NOTES:

VOLUNTEERS:

A big thank you to all those members who willingly give their time in helping in various ways and areas within the Bowls Club. Your efforts assist in keeping costs down and are much appreciated. However, there is always room for more volunteers to spread the load. Please contact a committee member if you are willing to help.

AVAILABLE RINKS:

The Greens Notice Board will signify which rinks and the direction of play. This advice must be strictly followed. Players in non-scheduled Club Championship games must write the game, time and date on the noticeboard provided.

TIME FOR COMMENCEMENT OF PLAY:

Greens are not available for any play prior to 10.00 a.m. unless shown otherwise in the Fixture and subject to Green maintenance requirements, weather conditions and providing the GREEN CLOSED sign is not displayed

GREEN CLOSED:

NO PLAY is allowed when a GREEN CLOSED sign is displayed on a Green.

MATS AND JACKS:

LEADS are responsible for the return of mats and jacks to the storage cupboard at the end of play. In addition, Scoops are to be returned to shelter storage locations.

Members of the nominated Duty Rink on Pennant Days are responsible to put away all mats, jacks, flags, scoreboards, scoops, etc. at the end of play.

KEYS TO GATES AND PAVILION:

A restricted key may be issued to a Bowls Member on request to the Secretary to provide access to gates, jack cupboard, external toilet and Bowls Pavilion Foyer entry doors, subject to a charge.

LAST OUT TO CHECK:

- 1) Lights out
- 2) Ceiling and wall fans off
- 3) Heating off
- 4) Windows closed
- 5) Bowls Pavilion locked
- 6) Green's gates locked
- 7) Air Conditioner off
- 8) External Toilet Locked & Lights off.
